



Linux ThinClient

Quick Installation Notes

Server Install --

Start by logging on to the console – from a graphical desktop running “gnome or kde”.

Step 1 – Login as “root”

Step 2 – Create users for “cbase” and “cbooks”. Make sure to also create a group “conetic”. Assign cbase and cbooks to the primary group “conetic”.

Step 3 – Copy the installation “CD” programs to your hard drive. Once copied change the file permissions by executing

```
# chmod gou+rxw ./bin <cr>
```

Note: If downloaded install file from the internet – you will need to untar the file. Using --

```
# tar -xvf ./filename <cr>
```

Step 4 – Install the server - Prior to running the install routine, you will need to verify that you have java installed on this machine. To verify java – 1) open browser; 2) goto the link below – to test and verify java.

Most linux systems use the **ice tea** java runtime. It is recommended that you use the OS software installation tools to add java support.

If java is installed – install programs by typing: # ./serverfile.bin <cr>

Step 5 – reboot the server

That's it ... your demo data and desktop icons for the "cbase and cbooks" users are ready to go!!!!

Step 6 – Install the Windows Thinclient -

Note: Accessing the system from a command prompt requires that you:

```
$ cd /home/conetic56 <cr>
```

Then set your environment by typing:

```
$ . ./sp <cr>
```

Standard/Default passwords:

Thinclient -

```
login: cbooks  
password: cbooks1
```

Thinclient Administrator -

```
login: administrator  
password: conetic
```

Visual Grace Edit -

```
login: cbooks  
password: cbooks1
```
